In celebration of the Women's Suffrage movement we are giving this scholarship in memory of **Mrs. George (Harriet) Ballou**, second president of the San Diego Woman's Club serving from 1893-1896. Mrs. Ballou was one of the San Diego leaders working on the passage of the 1911 California's 8<sup>th</sup> Amendment recognizing women's right to vote. The 8<sup>th</sup> Amendment passed, making California the 6<sup>th</sup> state to give women the vote.
