In celebration of the Women's Suffrage movement we are giving this scholarship in memory of **Mrs. George (Harriet) Ballou**, second president of the San Diego Woman's Club serving from 1893-1896. Mrs. Ballou was one of the San Diego leaders working on the passage of the 1911 California's 8th Amendment recognizing women's right to vote. The 8th Amendment passed, making California the 6th state to give women the vote.

- Must be planning to pursue a career in politics or government.
- Must have a GPA of 3.0 or higher.
