Dear San Diego High School Foundation, Inc. Supporters,

School year 2021-2022 has been phenomenal! Students are back 'in person', a major Modernization project has begun, graduation is back at the SDHS Balboa stadium and SDHS Foundation has been privileged to offer major support throughout the 2022 school year! With the efforts of our volunteer Board, we have been able to contribute financially to the following:

- *Granted 64 new College Scholarships and 40 renewable Scholarships: over \$150,000. (Granted over \$100,000 in new Scholarships per year over the past 6 years!)
- *Athletics support: Badminton, Soccer, Wrestling, Track & Field, "logos" for newly refurbished weight room that ALL students use: \$4,700.
- *Joined with the Alumni Association to purchase a 'multi use vehicle' for the campus: \$4,000.
- *Purchased a speaker/sound system for school-wide use: \$1,500.
- *Contributed toward the annual college campus tours: \$4,000.
- *Helped with the 'Caver Closet' where students can obtain free hygiene products and clothing: \$1,300.
- *Assisted with the purchase of dozens of printer ink cartridges for Art/Photography class: \$400.
- *Purchased 25 Blood Trauma Emergency Kits (Grant money) for campus use: \$1,600.
- *Financed purchase of a class set of U.S. History text books: \$1,600.
- *Provided funding for Visual & Arts and Special Ed. Seniors' end of year field trips: \$3,000.
- *Continued support to all Special Ed. programs for materials/supplies: \$3,000.
- *Provided Target gift cards, breakfast and raffle items for Staff Appreciation Day: \$8,000+.
- *Approved Sports Physicals Scholarships for student athletes: \$2,000.
- *Financed Senior Graduation stage/ramp, (15) yearbooks, various senior activities: \$4,500.
- *Provided for Worlds' Faire activity for all campus Clubs & Organizations: \$5,000.

As may be seen by this partial list of financial contributions, the level of funding we have provided for 2021-22 has been generous! Thank you to all who have sent donations and/or provided Grants to The SDHS Foundation, Inc. Our hope is to continue this level of funding!
